

2022 GOOD NEIGHBOR AWARD

Award Nomination Guidelines

The Menomonie Area Chamber & Visitor Center will recognize an individual or business that has dedicated their contributions of time, talents and treasures in the Menomonie Area.

Nominees for this award should encompass some or all of the following attributes:

- Provides a recognizable impact through volunteer services and activities
- Embodies a spirit of volunteerism, altruism and respect
- Supports and demonstrates a collaborative spirit and a high regard for community
- Inspires others by their example through demonstrated leadership and commitment
- Showcases ongoing support rather than a one-time effort
- Models high ethical conduct

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Good Neighbor Award, nominees:

- Are not required to be a Chamber Investor
- Must have engaged in recognizable Good Neighbor efforts within two years of the nomination
- Must have participated in service work beyond that of a financial contribution
- Possess attributes as listed above

Individuals and businesses are only eligible to receive an award in this category once in a ten year timespan. Nominees may receive nominations year-after-year if they are not selected for an award. Nominations are only be valid for the year they are submitted. If you are nominating an individual or business, you are encouraged to verify eligibility. Nominations that do not meet eligibility criteria or those without a completed nomination form inclusive of supporting narrative in each category will not be considered.

Application & Judging Process

Individuals and businesses that meet award eligibility criteria and receive a complete nomination will be considered for this award. Consideration of the top nominee will be given for most nominations and scoring from a criteria matrix set by the Menomonie Area Chamber & Visitor Center. The top nomination will be recommended by an award committee to the Chamber Board of Directors for final selection.

Nomination Process Timeline

December 1 - January 31: Nominations Accepted

February: Nominations Reviewed

March: Award Recipient Notified & Publicly Announced

May: Recipient Honored at the Annual Meeting & Awards Event

The Good Neighbor recipient will receive two complimentary tickets to the Annual Meeting & Awards, where they will be formally honored during the award ceremony. Award recipient information for this category will be released publicly prior to the Award night.
