


YOUNG PROFESSIONALS 🚳 🥴 📢

- Other actions which will align with and further the strategic direction of the Menomonie Area Chamber
























BUSINESS AFTER HOURS 🚳 📢

Through a partnership with the University of Wisconsin-Stout, we introduce investor businesses to thousands of students and University faculty and staff. In 2021, over 1,600 University students participated. Businesses are welcome to hand out food, non-alcoholic beverages, prizes and swag!



YOUTH CAREER EXPO 🚳 📢

Businesses are invited to connect with approximately 500 high school students from nine local school districts to promote employment, describe career pathways, and advocate for internships, co-ops, & youth apprenticeships. This expo style event is your opportunity to help educate and build our future workforce. Sponsorships from this event support the Chamber scholarship, which is available to graduating seniors throughout Dunn County who have a parent/guardian or grandparent who is employed by a Chamber member Investor business. A student working directly for a Chamber member Investor also meets qualification criteria.

CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN DOCUMENT SERVICE

To assist your business and to facilitate international trade, the Menomonie Area Chamber & Visitor Center offers Certificate of Origin processing. A Certificate of Origin is an international trade document attesting that goods in an export shipment are wholly obtained, produced, manufactured, or processed in a particular country. Completing your Certificate of Origin through the Menomonie Area Chamber & Visitor Center at no cost will provide your business with a range of benefits:

- Reduce the cost and time involved in making your Certificate of Origin applications
- Provide quicker turnaround times for applications and increase shipping efficiency
- Increase staff productivity and automate workflow
- Enhance the security of your document processing activities



How can my business use Chamber checks? Local businesses use Chamber checks for employee rewards, customer appreciation, as a marketing tool, and for various other programs.

Chamber checks are valid at over 100 participating Chamber Investor businesses, which means we are directing customers to your location and encouraging our community to support local businesses.

When presented with a Chamber check as payment, Investor businesses accept it as a normal check and provide cash back, if applicable.
If you notice a Chamber check is 120 days past the issue date, contact the Chamber office and we will issue you a replacement check.
